Volunteer tax preparers are required to complete IRS tax certification at the basic level through United Way of Greater Stark County's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program.

- Satisfaction of knowing that you had a direct impact on our community. Imagine helping someone put food on the table or saving a family from a mortgage foreclosure. As a VITA volunteer, you will help individuals and families keep their hard-earned money.

Last tax season through VITA, 93 IRS-certified volunteers donated 1688 hours preparing 4166 State and Federal tax returns. These trained volunteers saved tax-payers \$368,725, helped individuals find all possible credits and brought back over \$3 million back into the community with refunds.
